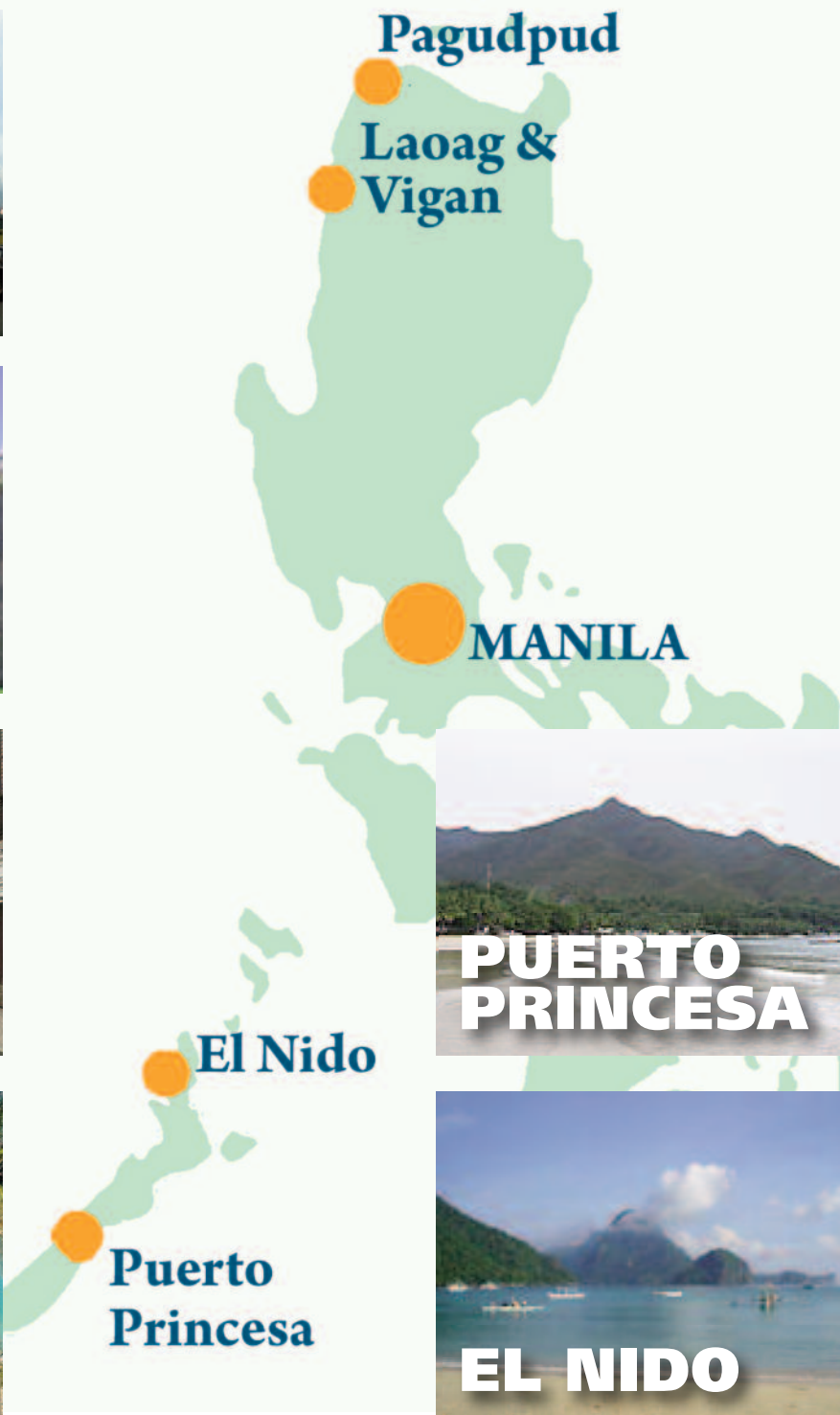

OUTLINE ITINERARY

Day 1 - Meet and Greet. Overnight in Manila.

Day 2 - Check out. Transfer to Airport. Flight to Laoag. Pick up from Airport. Start of Laoag, Batac and Paoay Tour. After the tour transfer to Vigan Hotel

Places to Visit - Laoag, Paoay and Batac:

Laoag Sinking Bell Tower, St William's Cathedral, Aurora Park, Sta. Monica Church, Museo Diocesano de Laoag, Marcos Birth Place, Malacanan of the North, Paoay Church, Marcos Mausoleum and Museum

Day 3 - Pick up from Hotel. Vigan Heritage Tour. Overnight in Vigan.

Places to Visit in Vigan

BAntay Bell Tower, Loom Weavers, Burgos Museum, St. Paul's Metropolitan Cathedral, Pagburnayan Pottery, Syquia Mamsion, Hotel Luna, Crisologo Museum, Baluarte, Hidden Garden, Calle Crisologo

Day 4 - Check out. Start of Pagudpud Day Tour. Check in at Resort

Places to Visit Pagudpud:

Burgos Light House, Kapurpurawan Rock Formation, Bangui Windmills, Saud Emohrou for Lunch by the Sea, Kabigan Falls (Swimming Optional), Patapat Viaduct, Paraiso Ni Anton, Blue Lagoon (Swimming Optional)

Day 5 - Free Time at Leisure enjoy the beach

Day 6 - Check out. Transfer to Airport. Flight back to Manila. Connecting flight to Puerto Princesa. Pick up from Airport. Transfer to Hotel



Laoag

Laoag is the provincial capital of Ilocos Norte, and is usually accessed by air in a short flight from Manila.

Many tourists visit Laoag to explore its heritage sites featuring Spanish colonial buildings, Philippine-baroque churches, stunning Paoay Church and Bell Tower, and Marcos-era mansions.



Vigan

Established in the 16th century, Vigan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site on the west coast of Luzon, is the oldest surviving Spanish colonial city in the country. It is also the best-preserved example of a planned Spanish colonial town in Asia, and has a unique European atmosphere.

Day 7 - Honda Bay Island Hopping, includes lunch, joining small group

Day 8 - St Paul's Underground River Tour, inclusive of Lunch

Day 9 - Check out. Transfer by air-con vehicle to El Nido. Free time at leisure.

Day 10 - El Nido Island Hopping Tour, includes lunch, joining group

Day 11 - Free Time at Leisure and to enjoy the beach

Day 12 - El Nido Cadlao Island Kayaking, includes lunch, joining group

Day 13 - Transfer to airport for Direct Flight to Manila. Overnight in Manila

Day 14 - Transfer to Airport for Flight home. End of Tour/Services

Pagudpud

North of Vigan can be found the beautiful beach of Pagudpud, located in Ilocos Norte.

Crystal blue waters and white sand makes Pagudpud a favourite destination among tourists. Pagudpud is secluded, calm and relaxed, making it a great getaway place to unwind.



Puerto Princesa

Several of Palawan's most beautiful beaches are to be found north of Puerto Princesa.

The beaches are seperated by the Sabang River which runs through mangroves. Sabang is situated close to the entrance to St Paul's Underground River. The area is rich with wildlife.

Underground River

Awarded World Heritage Site status in 1999, St Paul's Underground River is a national park running for 5 miles through a limestone cave before opening out into a lagoon.

This area is extremely active with wildlife, including Philippine macaques, monitor lizards and the highly endangered, flightless, tabon bird.
